Bill's favorite amateur radio band was 10 meters. He was a big fan of the 10 - 10 net and active until the 10 meter band all but failed due to the low sun spot cycle. He recently donated his HF station to the EARS radio club.

Bill had other interests in which he was very active. He toured the United States in his motor home with his wife Bella and they enjoyed traveling that way. Bill was active in the Masonic Lodge. He was a Past Master of the Delta Lodge in Braintree, Mass. and held leadership positions in several other masonic organizations, including the Shrine.

Bill served in the Navy during WWII, where he was an aircraft mechanic in the Pacific Theater of Operations.

Bill's health prevented him from attending our radio club meetings, but he and Bella did attend our Christmas Party in 2007 and 2008.
