Treasurer's Report – A motion to approve the report as published in the most recent newsletter was made by Tom Hawes, WA3PRC, seconded by Ken Blackshaw, W1NQT, approved and passed.

CORRESPONDENCE: No correspondence this month.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

 every morning.
- Hamfests –Fort Myers Jan. 19-20. Arcadia is the 27th, and Orlando starts the 9th of Feb.
- Field Day Ray Magsby FD June 23 and 24 in the Pavillion in South Gulf Cove. Pavillion has been reserved. Need to do this early because there are more residents over there now and the facility is in demand. Discussed the requirement for a deposit \$25. The Club will pick up the hors d'oeuvre tray expense. Dave asked for a show of hands about who would be there. The response was somewhat under-whelming. We had fifteen hands raised (counting guests).
