He also noted there is enough new and updated software to fill a hard drive on any computer. He did bring back a Rigblaster which interfaces a radio to a computer sound card and he is going to experiment with internet linking our radio to our families in Vancouver and Spokane Washington. The concept is to have a simplex link where we can call my brother in Vancouver on his mobile from our mobile in Englewood. We are initially going to try 146.540 simplex as long as we have no conflicts. It will be linked to Vancouver, WA. Feel free to listen or call CQ and see what happens. Since this is a web based link, hams from all over the world make CQ calls. We are using Echolink software and you can download it and get information about it on the web. When connected to the web, the software tells you who is connected by call sign and location. You do not need a radio to use the program. You do need a computer microphone and a call sign. The space bar is your PTT key. Keep in mind we are experimenting and open to suggestions and criticism.

Field Day is coming up this month on the 22^{nd} and 23^{rd} . It will be behind the Methodist church EARS meeting place and as in the past and we will have a family picnic on Sunday afternoon.
