I noted your quote from the QRZ.com page for W8OK. While I never heard Frank speak of "Skywarn" I know he was the founding father of the Dayton Hamvention, which became the largest hamfest in this country. He died just about the time a Hamvention was under way up in Dayton. Frank was also an active member of the TARC and QCWA Chapter 53--in fact, he snookered me into becoming the chapter president after him. I recall how Frank and his son-in-law built one of the early Elecraft radios—back when you had to wind all the torroids from scratch. Frank was so proud of that radio that he gave a program at OCWA describing its features. (Elecraft makes it a lot easier nowadays to assemble their great K3, etc.) Frank was strictly a CW DXer. No matter what any of us worked, when we told Frank of our accomplishment his standard response was "Junk DX." Frank used to winter over at the Ramblers Rest and there were enough ham snowbirds there that the owner gave them use of a buildings to set up a ham radio station. So, those are some of my memories of W8OK.
