DX REPORT

Since my last report propagation hasn"t changed all the much. 20m has been open and closed and noisy. 10m,15m and 12m have been the active bands the past three weeks,,, So follows what I think intersting contacts.

Chad (TT8TT) was on and I made two contacts on SSB, 20M and 17M. Than a few days later Tanzania (5H2DK) came on the air and my contact was on 10M SSB.
