Amateur Radio Demonstration

At 6:00 p.m. my shack, Vic-K4VHX, was invaded by an exuberant group of 16 girl scouts from troop 291. They came for a demonstration of amateur radio and we put on the best show we could, given the time and space available.

After some brief introductory remarks about our club, the hobby we viewed a video of Walter Cronkite's, discussion about ham radio. We then broke into three smaller groups of 5-6. One group stayed in the shack with me and talked on 20 meters and 2 meters; the second group went in the house with Pam-K1UEG for a demonstration of EchoLink and the third group went with my XYL, Liz, out on the Lanai to learn the International Phonetic Alphabet.

After 15-20 minutes the groups rotated to the next activity. I think all but two of the girls got to talk on the radio and or EchoLink. Several of the girls experienced 'mike fright' while talking on my transceivers but all were more comfortable talking on EchoLink. (Kids and computers!).

I talked to the girls about our clubs role during hurricane Charley, explained the role of local repeaters and what they would have to do to become licensed. All in all we kept them pretty busy for an hour and a half.
